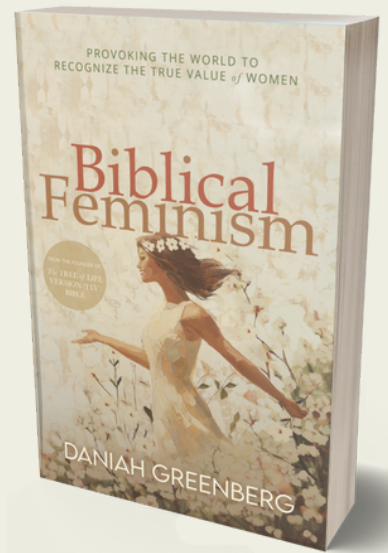

Apart from Adam, every single man in the Bible came out of a woman. Each woman born comes from the seed of a man. This is a genetically scientific fact, period. The Biblical narrative emphasizes that while men and woman are created uniquely different, they are equally essential and valuable in the tapestry of life.

However, evil wins when men and women are pitted against one another. But rest assured, evil always overplays its hand. **The deception of neo-Feminism is that it empowers women. The reality is, it sets them up for failure and destroys the foundational building blocks of family.**

In this book, Daniah Greenberg explores how the God of Israel defines genders with distinct roles and responsibilities that are critical to our health and wellbeing. Bible literacy reverses morale decline. A Jewish look at the Holy Scriptures will open your eyes to the truth.

Using her own life experiences, Daniah shares how the Bible truly develops and values 'daughters' as equally as 'sons.' She reveals that females and males hear Biblical truth based on the distinctives between how they are spoken to, represented, and commissioned in the Scriptures. Through her involvement in the creation of the Tree of Life Version of the Holy Scriptures (TLV), Daniah discovered simple Biblical truths that bring freedom and wellness to the lives of women and men alike. Biblical Feminism speaks with the voice of a mother in order to help adults build a deeper relationship with God and develop biblical patterns of living that lead to better relationships, work-life balance, and self-awareness.

WHY IS IT RELEVANT?

- With the arrival of neo-feminism, **women again find themselves unbalanced** and looking for a centrist truth that aligns with their faith. A more Hebraic perspective of the Bible helps them find that **truth**. The idea that the Bible includes the concept of feminism is shocking to many people, but without the knowledge of Hebrew culture and history, they'll never understand where to find feminism in its pages.
- The **feminine voice of the Holy Scriptures** has been eliminated from modern bible teaching and with it the **wisdom of a mother's heart**.
- While early feminism fought for equal rights (like suffrage), modern feminism's push for abortion and blurring gender lines often conflicts with biblical roles for men and women. All of that said ... is it possible to be a Christian feminist?

WHO IT'S FOR:

- Women, age 50-70, who believed that they raised their families with biblical values but see those values having been undermined so deeply that they are now concerned for their children and their children's children. They are dissatisfied with the failed construct of a non-denominational paradigm that has left families broken and hurt.
- Men, age 30-50, who want to be better faith examples to their children in partnership with the women they respect.
- Women, aged 25-45, who are ignorant of the Jewish lens towards women (which celebrates them instead of destroying them).
- Mothers of small children searching for help to inoculate their children against a world hostile to homegrown faith.

- What is biblical feminism and how does it differ from secular feminism?
- Why is the concept of Black Fire and White Fire in Judaism and why does it matter to Bible readers?
- Is biblical feminism dependent on biblical masculinity?
- Does society today willfully pit women against each other? Why?
- How does the Bible demonstrate the equal value of both men and women?
- Does God speak differently to women than He does to men?

Common questions and refrains regarding the compatibility of feminism and the Christian faith, that Daniah can tackle, include:

- Is modern feminism compatible with Christianity? Does feminism align with Christian teaching, particularly given the Bible's perceived patriarchal tone?
- Is the Bible inherently sexist or misogynistic? Many skeptics grapple with whether the Bible itself is sexist, often citing verses like 1 Timothy 2:11-15, which some interpret as limiting women's roles. Daniah's Hebraic perspective, which highlights the feminine voice in Scripture, directly addresses this concern by offering a lens that celebrates women's roles without dismissing the text. This question is pivotal for understanding Daniah's mission to emphasize biblical feminism as a way to empower women *through Scripture's lens*, not societal power struggles.
- How should Christians respond to gender roles in the church and marriage? What does a Jewish view of Scripture say? A tension exists between egalitarian and complementarian views. Egalitarians (aligned with feminist theology) push for equal roles, while complementarians argue for distinct, God-ordained roles (e.g., men as leaders, women as submissive in marriage). Some critique the use of "patriarchal" as a loaded term that implies misogyny in church leadership.



When I was a child, I knew God. I have always known He existed. Then, life happened, and nothing felt right. I think I am doing life backwards. Frankly, I know I am.

I learned mothering before adulthood. I learned guilt before I understood what mistakes I was making. I learned sex before love. I fell in love with my child before my husband. I was a creative before I knew what I was created for. Then I came to the revelation that life can only be understood backwards; but must be lived moving forward.

As a little girl, I was endlessly creative. I did not understand when people would say that I was “gifted” or a prodigy. In retrospect, I understand now that I was a spark plug of a person, only in a child’s limited body. I was confused by the tragedies around me. I knew down deep that I was special, so why were these terrible things happening? I wonder who I would have become had I known who I truly was created to be. Is that the big mystery?

What do you do when no one teaches you how to “do life” because they had no one to teach them, either? How can you sift the truth from the lies when motives are hidden, and ceilings are glass and you are hungry for more?

What is the turning point when looking for help becomes a fistfight? How many times do children’s hearts get scared and their brains wired with landmines? How do I exist within the binary universe between my heart and mind?

Answering these questions took a lifetime, but I found a faith that makes sense to me. My Creator inspired me to reverse engineer the ancient scrolls of Judaism to sift out seven Sacred Truths that can put just about anybody “right side up” who thinks their life is upside down. Reverse engineering, also called back engineering, is the process by which you deconstruct a thing to reveal a hidden design or extract knowledge. I just so happened to use this process on the Bible.

Faith is a given in this book, not a religion. Hope is the protagonist or central character of my story, not me. I was not raised in a religious family. My journey to know God began long before I ever read about Him. I only know that one day He found me. I live life on a daily adventure with God that eclipses any desire to figure Him out. He is just near, with me, never late and relentlessly interested in my hopes and my dreams coming true.

I live in the suddenly and surprises of His closeness and I spend precious moments each day giggling about how He reveals Himself to others in the most profound and unique ways. I only ask that you read this book with that in mind. Feel free to take small sips or large gulps, but know that either way, you are feasting on a full palate of experiences. You cannot taste the sweet without the salty and you cannot know the savory without knowing the bitter. This book will challenge you to look at the God of Israel – the God of the Bible differently – because the Bible was never created to control people with religion. The Bible is a handbook for living life at peace with others, knowing ultimately God gave us a clear pattern of how to autocorrect our thinking and live life fully alive by becoming His child. As I share my true-life tale of overcoming evil and alienating chaos, let me assure you that the same ancient truths of 3400 years ago are still true today – if you dare to believe ‘in Spirit and in truth’ at the same time.

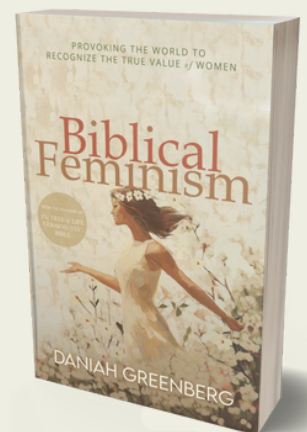
The first gift God ever gave you was life: breath, blood and seed. Then, God created a space inside mankind to need Him. The interesting part is that God makes spaces inside places and inside times. You will find the spaces between letters, between words, between people, between doorposts and between gates – according to the God of the Universe.

This book can also show you how to make peace with your Creator, because the second gift God ever gave was choice. That is why I believe that reading the Bible keeps revealing mankind asking the same question, “Who is like God in all the earth?” again and again over the ages. There is none like God. Spiritual hunger is real.

Think of your most basic needs: food, clothing and shelter. Coming home to a warm dinner and arms filled with love seems simple... unless you don’t have that. ‘Fullness’ is truly the cry of humanity resounding in the wailing of children around the world.

I can show you the Jewish route, the way, to be spiritually full and stop the root causes of loss and pain. God hid His most basic and simple truths in the oldest manuscripts of the Jewish Bible, but they are inside the white spaces between the black letters. Calling attention to the hidden things of God would cause riots in the streets if plainly stated!

Why? Because mankind refuses to believe that God is unsearchable. Read the Book of Genesis and let’s reason together. Step-by-step, come to your own conclusions. Can you trust the God of the ancient scrolls? Is your life just a Divine Comedy, where you pass through hell and purgatory on your way to heaven, or is there a pathway to the actual Tree of Life that is waiting in the middle of Gan Eden (Garden of Eden), guarded by a flaming sword? I have discovered there was, in the beginning, a Garden of Eden. And I know how to get back there. Getting back to Eden, back to that perfect dimension, takes a strategic journey. Through the seven sacred truths I’m about to share with you, you can learn the steps to discover this spiritual pathway to shalom and save the innocent – the children of light – with God.



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
